

Movement to Alert Level 3


28 August 2021

We will be moving into Level 3 at midnight next Tuesday. The majority of our students will continue to learn from home, but we will have a limited capacity for students onsite in our 'bubble' classes.

Can I send my child to school in Level 3?

During the announcement on Friday afternoon the Prime Minister made it very clear that the focus in Level 3 is to limit all contact as much as possible, and that students should continue to learn from home if at all possible.

If you are not sure if you should be sending your child to school, please use the diagram below.



Many of us are experiencing 'cabin fever' after almost two weeks in Level 4. However, with the characteristics and the level of transmission of the Delta variant, the safest place for your children is at home.

Children with a higher risk of complications from COVID19 are encouraged to stay at home.
